As a concerned traveler, I am shocked to learn that Air France is one of the few major airline companies that still transports primates bound for research labs. Air France has ignored repeated requests to stop transporting primates despite public outcry.

The monkeys experience extreme temperature fluctuations, poor ventilation and debilitating noise that causes stress, trauma, dehydration, and intestinal hemorrhaging.
