
Last Chance for Animals Study June 2020

This study was conducted on June 2nd and 4th, 2020, among a sample of 1,042 respondents who are residents of Ontario and part of Maru/Blue's research panel. The study was conducted through online surveys. A probabilistic sample of a similar size would have a margin of error of plus or minus 3%, 19 times out of 20.

Where and how is the study conducted?

The study included respondents from an online panel of Canadians, 18 years of age or older. The sample is weighted to regional, age and gender demographics, as per Statistics Canada.






Maintaining sanitary processes in the food chain - Age and Gender






IS1 - Do you believe that maintaining sanitary processes and preventing disease in the food chain is important when raising animals for food in Ontario? n = 1042










IS5 - How important is it to you that animals raised for food on farms are raised in hygienic conditions? n = 1042






IS7 - When it comes to the sanitation of meat processing plants in Ontario which view is closest to your own? n = 1042




IS8 - How important is it to you that meat be processed in sanitary conditions in Ontario? n = 1042




IS9 - When it comes to the treatment of workers in meat processing plants in Ontario which view is closest to your own: n = 1042










IS14 - Do you believe that it is important for whistleblowers to be able to expose conditions for animals on farms and meat processing plants? n = 1042




IS15 - Do you believe that it is important for whistleblowers to be able to expose hygiene, sanitation and food safety conditions on farms and meat processing plants? n = 1042






