Description of Program Service One

Education and Public Outreach

LCA strives to educate the public about animal cruelty and exploitation through websites, brochures, email alerts, mailings and newsletters. All of these educational tools are valuable resources for the public as they contain information on a variety of animal rights issues, encourage readers to take action and provide an opportunity to update members about LCA activities.

LCA's newsletter, "Fighting Chance," reaches 100,000 members and the main website (www.LCAnimal.org) receives over 300,000 hits a month.. LCA's e-mail action alerts ask for "Calls to Action" from members about issues needing urgent attention. Members are e-mailed information and asked to make a phone call or to write a fax or letter to help bring about needed changes for animals.

LCA's founder and president, Chris DeRose, is frequently interviewed for television and radio programs, newspapers and magazines, nationally and internationally. He also travels both in the U.S. and abroad, giving lectures and educating the public about animal rights. Countless people have read or heard about LCA and Chris DeRose through the 55-60 interviews in 2014.

Locally, LCA and the Animal News Van (ANV), attends special events, conferences, schools and fund raisers. LCA's custom-made, donated ANV is equipped with two large

powerful medium of video to educate citizens about the current conditions animals live in by showing investigative reports and disseminating breaking news stories. Special emphasis is given to schools, educating students and encouraging them to adopt a compassionate, cruelty-free lifestyle. Attendees at each event range from 30-300.

LCA held protests against Air France, at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), and provided information to supporters for protests in other cities. Air France is the last major European airline that still transports tens of thousands of primates a year for cruel and invasive animal experimentation. Air France passenger and Air France-KLM cargo planes transport monkeys, often stolen from wild habitats in Vietnam and the Republic of Mauritius. LCA's petition urging Air France to stop transporting primates, signed by thousands, was delivered to Executives at Air France in the U.S. and France. LCA had billboards "Air France Flies Monkeys to Lab Cruelty" near LAX and Air France offices in Times Square, New York.

LCA, was part of a coalition that succeeded in getting the government of India to issue a directive to stop transport of animals across the Indo-Nepal border during the world's largest animal sacrifice at the Gadhimai festival in November 2014. This was a major win as 70 percent of sacrifice participants come from Indian states, bringing animals with them across the border. The festival occurs every five years, with more than five million people attending to pay tribute to the Hindu goddess of power. Unfortunately, many believe that bloodshed will appease the goddess and bring them luck. Typically, 500,000 animals are sacrificed, but India's ban is estimated to have saved 200,000 animal lives. The campaign to End the Sacrifice continues to put the pressure on the Nepalese government to end the brutal slaughter.

LCA held the 11th annual Puppy Mill Awareness Day (PMAD) in September 2014 in Austin, TX. This event, attended by approximately 500 people, sponsored by LCA, seeks to end the cruel business of puppy mills by educating the public about their deplorable conditions and to encourage people to adopt animals through rescue organizations and shelters.

Description of Program Service Two

Investigations:

Last Chance for Animals (LCA), often referred to as the "FBI of Animal Rights," is widely known for its Special Investigation Unit (SIU) that conducts in-depth investigations to expose horrible cruelty and misuse of animals. The SIU team focuses on validating information, detecting suspect activity, exposing illegal or unethical activities and reporting them to local, state and federal authorities for prosecution. The information obtained in LCA's investigations is used to develop campaigns, provide grassroots education and outreach to the public, and to help in drafting legislation that will bring lasting changes for the animals. The scope of LCA's investigations includes, but is not limited to: pet theft, class "B" dealers, puppy mills, pound seizure, circus cruelty, elephants in captivity, vivisection and pharmaceuticals manufactured from the demise of animals.

LCA's Special Investigation Unit provided undercover footage of the dog meat industry in China that was used to launch the Stop Dog Meat campaign. The campaign is focused on ending the dog meat trade and the annual Yulin Dog Meat Festival. Every year, an

estimated 10 million dogs are killed for their meat in China. The dogs are trucked long distances in cramped wire cages before they are tortured, beaten, boiled or skinned alive. LCA's undercover investigation team continues to document and expose China's dog meat industry and provide information to authorities to get the slaughterhouses shut down.

In October 2014, the National Health Institute of Health (NIH), the largest funder of biomedical research in the US, announced they have stopped funding research that involves dogs obtained from USDA licensed Class B dealers. LCA has played a leading role in the investigation, prosecution and conviction of USDA licensed Class B dealers, who provide "random source dogs" (often stolen pets) to research facilities for cruel and invasive experiments. Class B dealers are known for the horrible abuses they inflict on the animals and the filthy conditions they are kept in. This NIH ban follows a similar ban involving cats from Class B dealers which was adopted in 2012. In 2003, LCA concluded a 15-year investigation into B dealers and handed the case over to the U.S. Attorney's office which prompted the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to charge the largest and most notorious dealer with more than 100 violations of the animal welfare act. This was the first time a U.S. Attorney's office took on an animal rights case. LCA's SIU undercover operations obtained 70 hours of footage and proof of horrendous abuse at the B dealer's property. In 2005, the same dealer was fined the largest fine ever imposed by the USDA and his license was permanently revoked. In 2006, civil and criminal charges were settled against the B dealer. This precedent setting case is a big win for the animals and has set case law. Due to this Federal felony conviction, this B dealer can no longer vote, bear arms, have any dealing with animals in any way and must report to a probation officer. Other B dealers are still operating until the Pet Safety & Protection Act

(which will prohibit class B dealers from supplying animals to research facilities) is passed into law. LCA's harrowing investigation into this class B dealer was the subject of HBO's America Undercover 2006 documentary, "Dealing Dogs". Currently, there are still five "random source" Class B dealers; hundreds of dog dealers have been put out of business or quit in large part due to LCA's work. LCA will continue to campaign against the use of live animals in scientific experimentations.
